- III. WIDENED SIDEWALK




TYPICAL OFF ROAD TRAIL SECTION

In accordance with the mission of Portage Park District to provide safe offroad trails for their users, a substantial portion of the Southwest Portage County Trail and Greenway Plan is off road. This typical trail section will have a ten foot (10 ft) wide asphalt or crushed stone surface with a two foot (2 ft) shoulder on either side. The slopes on each side of the trail will have a maximum slope of 2:1 with a two foot rounding.




TYPICAL OFF ROAD TRAIL SECTION

WITHIN THE PROPOSED TRAIL ALIGNMENT, A NUMBER OF SEGMENTS REQUIRE THE USE OF AN EXISTING ROADWAY. TYPICALLY, ROADWAYS ARE MODIFIED TO PERMIT A TEN FOOT (10 FT) AND A FIVE FOOT (5 FT) BUFFER/UTILITY ZONE. TYPICALLY, A SIDEPATH INCLUDES A TWO FOOT (2 FT) SHOULDER WHICH WILL BE THE STANDARD ON ALL OTHER SIDEPATHS OR ON-ROAD TRAILS WITHIN THE SOUTHWEST PORTAGE COUNTY TRAIL AND GREENWAY PLAN




TYPICAL WIDENED SIDE-WALK SECTION

THE PROPOSED TRAIL ALIGNMENT RECOMMENDS
THE USE OF A WIDENED SIDEWALK ON NUMEROUS
SEGEMENTS OF THE OVERALL PLAN. TYPICAL WIDENED SIDEWALKS ARE TEN FEET (10 FT) WIDE AND
SEPARATED FROM THE ROADWAY BY A FIVE FOOT (5
FT) UTILITY OR VEGETATIVE BUFFER.




